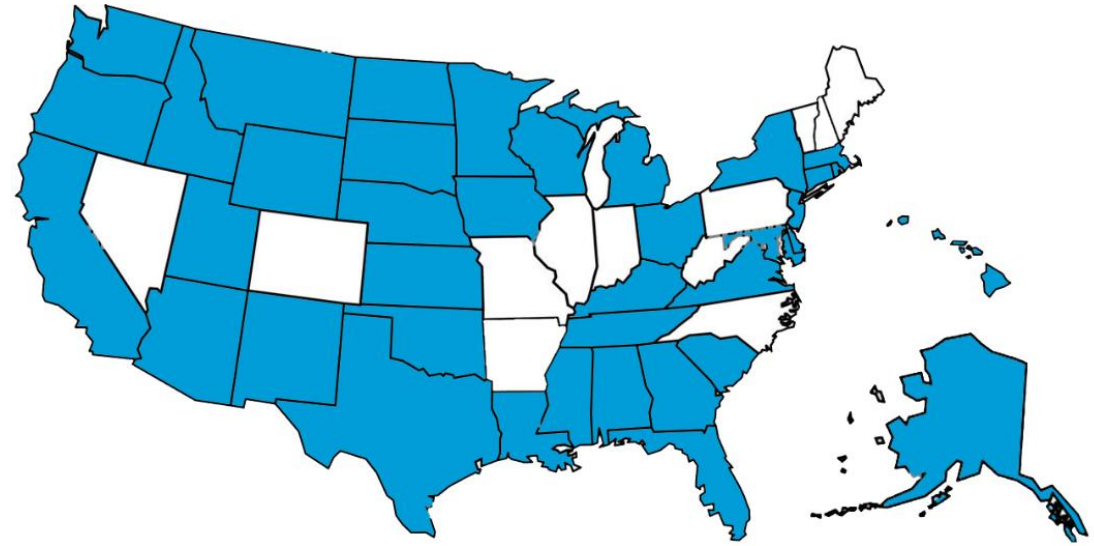

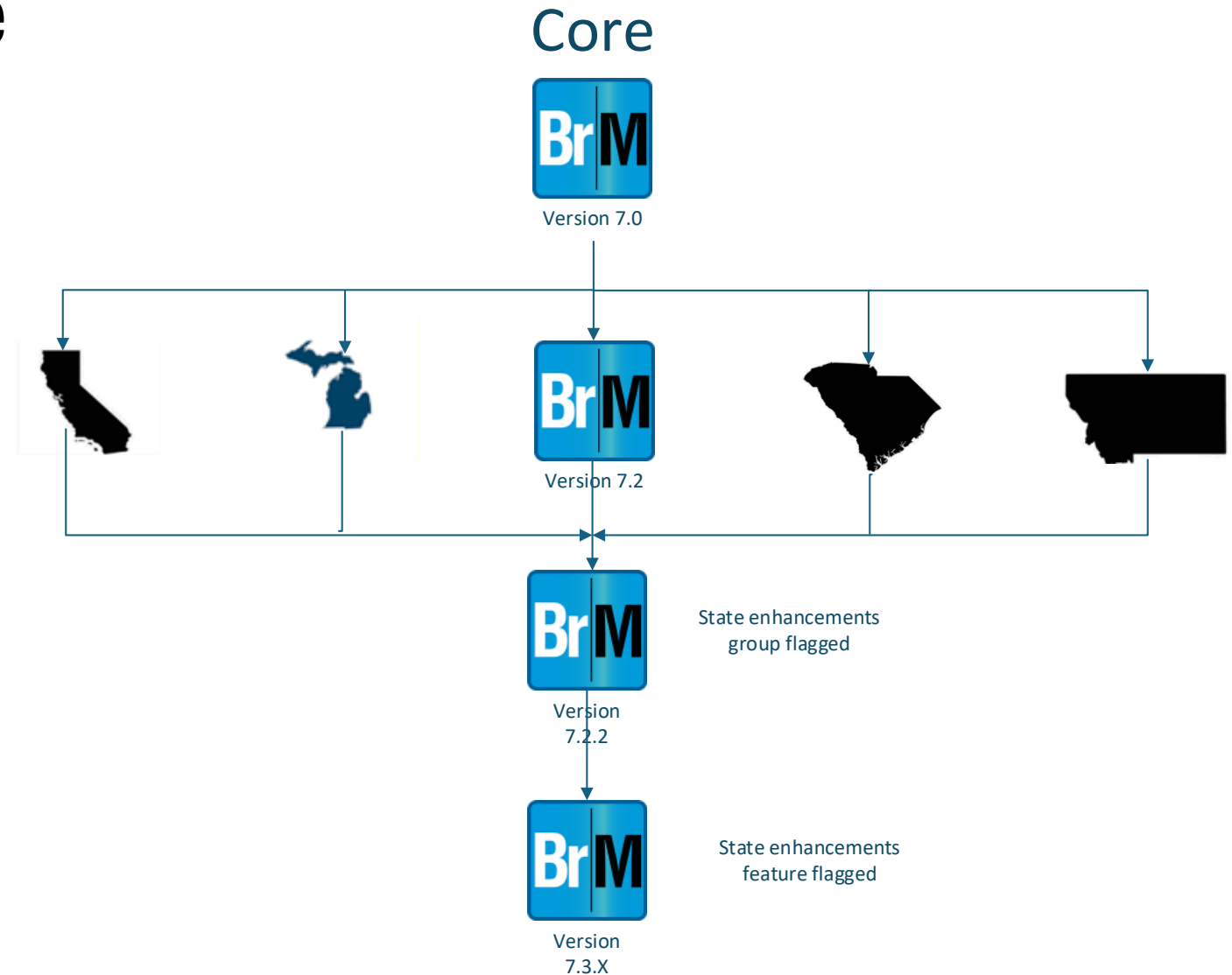

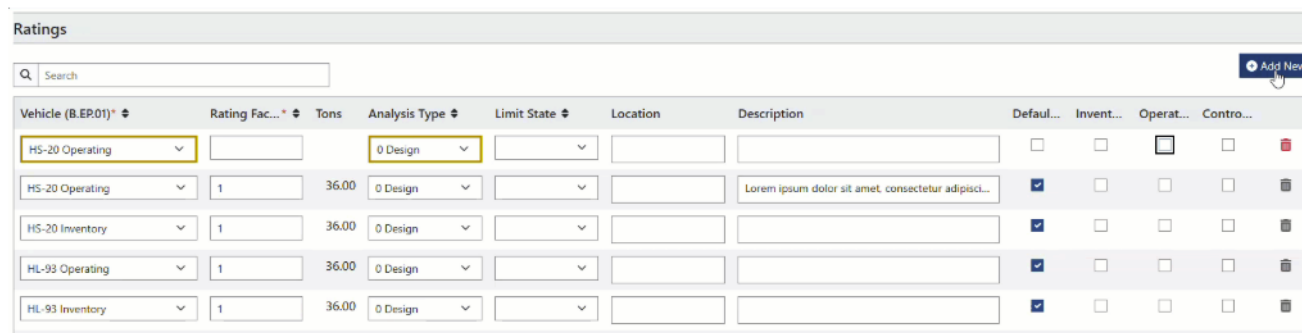

Return to the Core



Improving Usability

- With the ADA compliance and other changes in BrM 7.x, usability can be improved
- Concerted effort to improve usability to BrM without losing ADA compliance and other update
- 7.2.2 includes 2 controls updated to improve usability
- Future releases will include improving other controls

Return to Emphasis on User Selected Enhancements

- For 3 years BrM concentrated on the 7.0/7.1/7.2 enhancements. This limited availability of resources for new features. With SNBI largely completed and ADA completed, more resources can be dedicated to User Selected Enhancements
- It is important for all member agencies to provide their list of wants and needs for BrM in Jira
- The Task Force is going to start a process for going through the enhancement list to identify those already completed and combine those that are common into a single deliverable

Optimization

- With SNBI and ADA completed, the Task Force is committed to enhance the Optimization functionality in BrM

New processes for SU enhancements

- Service Unit work will be more collaborate with cost sharing between the member agencies.
- The goal will be to create functionality that everyone can use instead of bridging gaps for individual agencies
- Service Unit work must have a way to ensure an agency is not stuck with that function if they don't need it
